- Efforts have begun to receive from the Vatican a recognition of the charism of SASE.

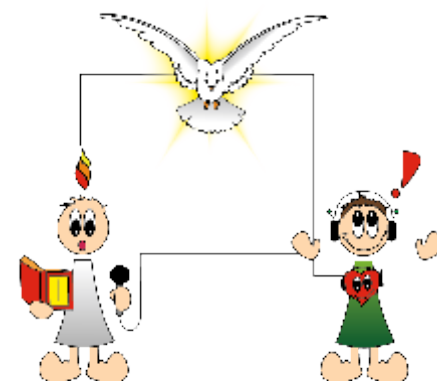
